
- 1) Short essay to address:
 - Educational plans and career goals.
 - School or community activities in which you have participated (including church, service clubs, and volunteer positions, etc.)
 - Significant honor, award, or achievement and what you learned from the experience that will aid you in being successful in higher education.
 - Affiliation with your church family and what this has meant to you, and what impact you see for the future.
 - Reasons for applying for this scholarship.
- 2) Current copy of your transcript.

3) Two letters of reference, one from your pastor and one from school staff. (Returning students may request letter from their employer.)

4) Completed application
