Taking It Outside!

“And they went out and preached the good news everywhere...”
Mark 16:20

We want to expand our ministry! We envision doing so by building a patio which will serve as an outdoor worship space and fellowship area on our back lawn. Although we will be sharing this vision at our Annual Congregational Meeting on Sunday, June 26th, immediately following worship, here are some answers to questions you may have...

Where did this idea come from?

During the pandemic, many of us wanted to worship in the safest possible way, and without the requirement of wearing masks. In order to accomplish this goal, and stay with guidelines issued by the state, our only option was to hold worship outdoors. While we worshipped on our back lawn, we came to love the incredible view of the mountains, while enjoying God’s creation. However, we did not always find the uneven lawn to be the easiest surface to navigate, especially for those with mobility concerns.

What is the plan for the patio?

The Property Ministry Team has been working on this proposed project for many months. Ron Lodge designed a space which accommodates both worship and fellowship needs. The underground power and sound system infrastructure beneath the patio will make setting up outdoor worship much easier. We will even be able to livestream from our new outdoor space!

How much is this going to cost?

We are still working on final numbers, but it will cost tens of thousands of dollars. We will share more accurate numbers with you when all the final estimates are in, and evaluated. A portion of the cost is already funded through existing funds and early pledges to the project. The Property Ministry Team presented this concept to the Session, and it was unanimously endorsed! We believe it will significantly enhance our ministry.

Is this the only major property project?

Even though we have made significant interior renovations in recent years, the exterior of our building needs some upgrades. New exterior doors, an exterior paint job, and a security camera system are also being proposed by the Property Ministry Team, and the Session has already approved the funding of new doors from our Memorial Funds. We believe these additional enhancements will serve us well into the future, and make our facility more safe and secure for those who worship here, and also those who use the facilities throughout each week.

For more than two decades, the youth and leaders from Canyon Hills Community Church in Bothell have been visiting our church facility each summer. This year, they are staying our facility from Sunday, June 26th to Wednesday, June 29th.

While in the Wenatchee Valley, the group volunteers with different ministries, including the Wenatchee Rescue Mission (formerly Hospitality House). They also participate in some worship services of local Hispanic congregations. They do this as part of their training for larger mission trips elsewhere. In the past, they have gone to Chile. Due to travel restrictions, they are going to Tucson, Arizona this year.

In addition to volunteering at ministries around the valley, they also help us with projects around the church. Like last year, we will have them help us with some exterior painting. Given that our facility is a single story high, this is accessible for the youth.

Alex Croutworst, the Elementary Age Pastor at Canyon Hills Community Church, stopped by the church recently, in preparation for their upcoming visit. He said that our church's hospitality towards their group makes it possible for them to come each year. He is very grateful to our church. While we do have to give up the use of our facility for a few days in order to accommodate the youth, it is the right thing to do. Plus, they always leave the facility better than when they arrive, and have helped us with some significant building and grounds projects over the years. I praise God for our continuing partnership with a fellow Christian church, in furthering the proclamation of the gospel, and the training of young people.
