As you may have noticed, work on our Patio of Praise continues. We were fortunate to find a contractor, Evan McCallister, who was able to start within days of the final decision by the Property Ministry Team, which reviewed four different offers.

So far, the area for the patio has been excavated. Then the trenches were dug, and electrical conduit and sprinkler pipes installed and inspected, and then the trenches were filled back in. Next will come the installation of the base for the concrete slab pour, as well as the construction of the forms.

Nehemiah mentions the names of all who participated in the rebuilding, including the specific parts of wall they rebuilt. In the same way, I would be remiss without crediting Elder Scott Kruse with All-Phase Electric, who is our main electrician for the project, as well as Ron Lodge, who has volunteered countless hours on the project dealing with sprinkler lines, low-voltage electrical, and conduit for the sound system.

It is exciting to see this project progress. Hopefully, we will be able to use our "Patio of Praise" for an outdoor worship service sometime this month! Pray that it happens!

Choir Resumes Practicing this month!

At a potluck dinner on Wednesday, August 31st, our choir discussed plans for the school year. Yet our first item of business (besides eating, always important at a delicious potluck!), was to celebrate our ability to schedule regular practices. We had needed to limit practices due to Covid, starting at the beginning of the pandemic. Although the choir did come together briefly for a few practices and performances at Eastertime, this fall marks is the first resumption of year-long choir practice in more than two years. Hallelujah!

We made three significant changes to our choir practice schedule, changing the frequency, day of the week, and time of our practices.

Choir practices will take place every other Tuesday, at 4:00pm, beginning on Tuesday, September 13th. You are welcome to join us!

Here is the rationale behind the changes:

Everyone is busy, and many choir members cannot attend every week. Thus, the change to practicing every other month benefits them.

In comparing schedules, we discovered that Tuesdays, rather than Wednesdays, seemed to be the optimal day for our practices.

We decided to go with a 4:00pm start time for our practices, as that will minimize conflicts with evening commitments, and allow choir members to drive while it is still light. (Our previous start time was more than an hour later).

In all likelihood, you will hear the choir perform during worship on Sunday, October 2nd, World Communion Sunday. Until then, please pray for your choir, and considering joining. We are always open to new members!
